

**RESOLUTION NUMBER #08192025 TO ADOPT PROPERTY TAX RATE
for Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 5**

BE IT CONSIDERED by the Board of Commissioners of Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 5 (the "District"), that

WHEREAS the District is authorized by Chapter 775 of the Health and Safety Code to levy ad valorem taxes within the district and is also required to annually set a tax rate,

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2025, at a public meeting, the District proposed a tax rate and scheduled a public hearing in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act,

WHEREAS the District caused to be published in a local newspaper and on the departmental website a notice listing last year's tax rate, this year's proposed tax rate,

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2025, at a public meeting, the District considered adopting a total tax rate of \$0.099986 per \$100 for 2025,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

1. Upon separate motion, and by record vote, the District Board of Commissioners adopts a M&O tax rate of \$0.080330 per \$100 of taxable property within the district for Tax Year 2025.

Motion: I, TOMMY SLADCEK, move that the M&O property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.080330, which is effectively a 3.50% percent increase in the M&O tax rate.

2. Upon separate motion, and by record vote, the District Board of Commissioners adopts an I&S tax rate of \$0.019656 per \$100 of taxable property within the district for Tax Year 2025.

Motion: I, BILL LAWSON, move that the I&S property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.019656, which is effectively a 0.33% percent decrease in the I&S tax rate.

After due consideration, upon separate motion, and by record vote, the District Board of Commissioners adopts a total tax rate of \$0.099986 per \$100 of taxable property within the district for Tax Year 2025. Of this amount, \$0.080330 is the maintenance and operations (M&O) rate and \$0.019656 is the debt service (I&S) tax rate.

Motion: I, Janet Hage, move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.099986, which is effectively a 3.70% percent increase in the tax rate.

5. THIS TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.50% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$2.72.

6. This resolution will be filed by the Secretary of the District and a copy provided to the Williamson County Tax Assessor-Collector.
